Considerations

1 START WITH WHAT YOU LOVE

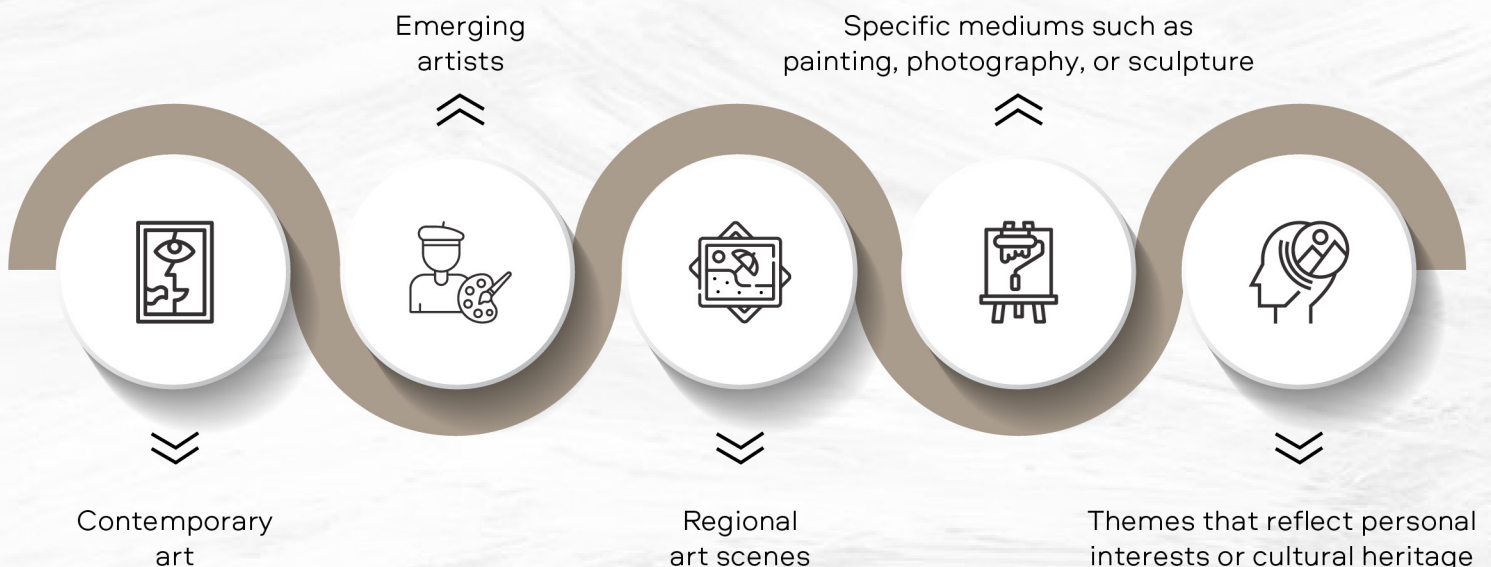
The most successful collections often begin with a simple emotional response. Rather than focusing solely on market trends or investment potential, choose artworks that genuinely resonate with you. A collection built around personal taste is more likely to remain meaningful and enjoyable over time.

Visit galleries, exhibitions, art fairs, and artist studios whenever possible. The more art you experience, the more confident you become in identifying the styles, themes, and artists that speak to you.

2 DEFINE YOUR COLLECTING DIRECTION

A collection does not need to follow a strict theme, but having a **clear direction can help create cohesion over time.**

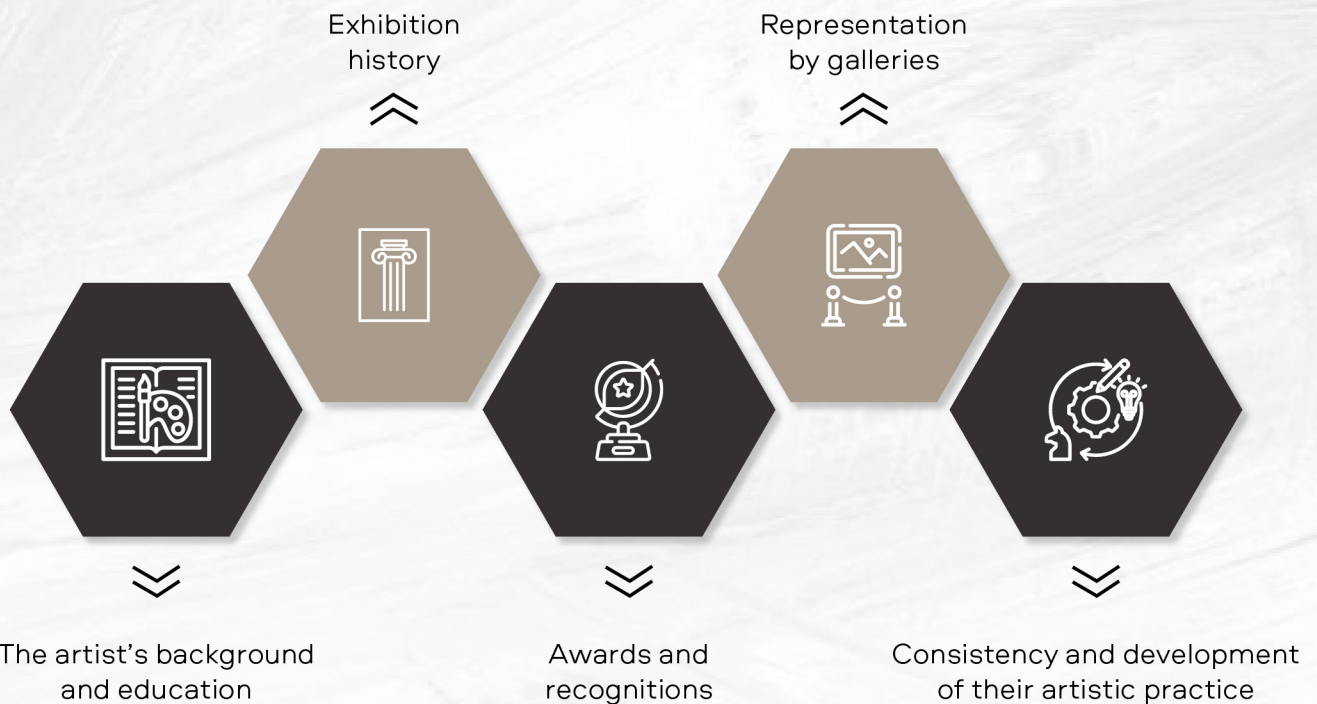


Your collection should tell a story that is uniquely yours.

3 LEARN ABOUT THE ARTIST

4 BEGIN GRADUALLY

Start with pieces that fit comfortably within your budget and allow your collection to grow naturally over time. **Collecting should be a journey, not a race.**

5 FOCUS ON QUALITY OVER QUANTITY

A thoughtful collection is not measured by the number of artworks it contains, but by the quality and significance of each piece.

It is often better to **acquire one exceptional artwork that holds long-term meaning than several pieces chosen impulsively.**

6 CONSIDER PROFESSIONAL GUIDANCE

Working with trusted galleries and art advisors can help collectors navigate the market with confidence. **Professional guidance provides valuable insights into artists, provenance, pricing, and collection strategy.**

A reputable gallery can become a long-term partner in building and refining a collection.

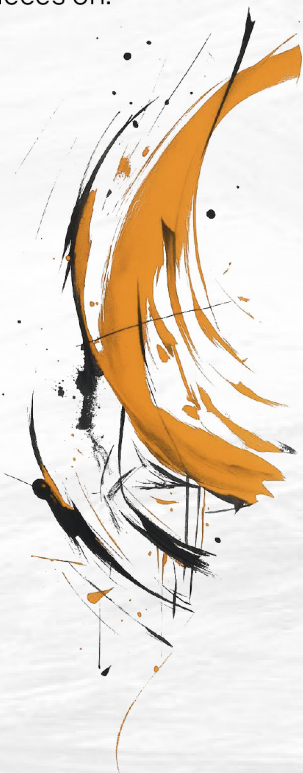
7 THINK BEYOND INVESTMENT

8 DOCUMENT EVERYTHING
